GENERAL REGULATION

- Participants must use their own equipment;
- It is not possible to hire the equipment (for participants coming from abroad, please remember to bring adapters for Swiss sockets.);
- The awards are as follows: the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will win a cup, from 4th to 10th place will win a medal;
- Audience Social Award: for each category, is going to be awarded the picture that will receive more like on social networks;
- Each participant can only use the work space with the mirror and two sockets (for the participants coming from abroad, please remember to bring adapters for Swiss sockets.);
- In order to take part in the 1st, 2nd and 3rd year competition and CaHairNival for apprentices, the participants coming from abroad must be enrolled in a school;
- You must take part in the competition of your training year, if you want to participate in the CaHairNival competition.

1st year

Fashion brushing with accessory (single work.)

It starts at 11 AM. Available time: 30 minutes

- Hair must be completely wet, not only moistened
- Hair must be combed back without preparation
- Hair must be completely worked with brushes and hairdryers
- Heating tools are allowed
- Styling and finish products are allowed
- It is compulsory to add a day theme accessory that does not exceed $\frac{1}{4}$ of the head (hair extensions, hairpins, feathers, pins etc.)
- Hair cannot be fully gathered
- Interlacements are not allowed

P.S. Please remember that by participating in your category you can also take part in the higher category and in the CaHairNival competitions.

2nd year

Hairstyle (single work.)

It starts at 12 PM. Available time: 40 minutes.

- Hair can be prepared before the beginning of the competition (waves, curls, crimped hair, hair straightener, hairstyle with rollers etc.)
- The hairstyle must have at least an interlacement technique at your choice
- Hair must be fully styled
- Tools for support and volume are allowed up to a maximum of 1/3 of the head
- Extensions are not allowed
- In the initial preparation is not allowed to backcomb
- Accessories are not allowed.

3rd year

Fashion man or woman haircut (single work.)

It starts: 1.10 PM Available time: 60 minutes

Woman regulation:

- Cut at least 5 centimeters on the whole perimeter of the head
- Hair must be fully wet and combed back without separations
- Haircut can be done before or after the drying process
- It is allowed to use the hair clipper with or without attachments
- Hair must be styled with brush and hairdryer, and it is allowed to use heating tools
- Styling and finish products are allowed

Man regulation:

- Cut at least 2 centimeters on the whole perimeter of the head
- It is allowed to use the hair clipper with or without attachments
- Hair must be styled with brush and hairdryer, and it is allowed to use heating tools
- It is not allowed to do the whole haircut only with the hair clipper
- It is not allowed to do a haircut compensation

CaHairNival apprentices

A world of carnivals:

Plunge into your phantasy and elaborate your carnival.
(individual or couple work for apprentices, on single model man or woman.)

It starts 2.40 PM available time: 60 minutes

- Hair must be fully worked
- Hair must be presented dried, back combed and must not present any kind of processing
- Heating tools are allowed
- Hairpieces and ornaments must not exceed the 2/3 of the head and must be presented on a polystyrene mannequin head
- Clothes, make-up and accessories are part of the work

CaHairNival professionals

A world of carnivals:

Plunge into your phantasy and elaborate your carnival.
(individual or couple work for apprentices, on a single model man or woman.)

It starts 2.40 PM available time: 60 minutes

- Hair must be fully worked
- Hair must be presented dried, back combed and must not present any kind of processing
- Heating tools are allowed
- Hairpieces and ornaments must not exceed the 2/3 of the head and must be presented on a polystyrene mannequin head
- Clothes, make-up and accessories are part of the work

Pre-jury

Pre-jury is made up of a pre-jury chief and other members.

The aim of the pre-jury is to verify that general regulation is respected and that participants do not receive suggestions from outside of the arena.

Trespassers will be penalized on their score, based on the gravity.

In the pre-jury there is an observing of the hairdresser apprentices to transmit to his colleagues the complete transparency of the pre-jury.

Jury

Jury is made up of a chief jury and other members, at the end it judges the works and gives scores.

Every member of the jury must give his score once.

In the jury there is an observing of the hairdresser apprentices to transmit to his colleagues the complete transparency and honesty of professional judgement of the jury.

The works that are off-topic and the hairstyles that are not allowed in the regulation will be penalized giving them the lowest score.
